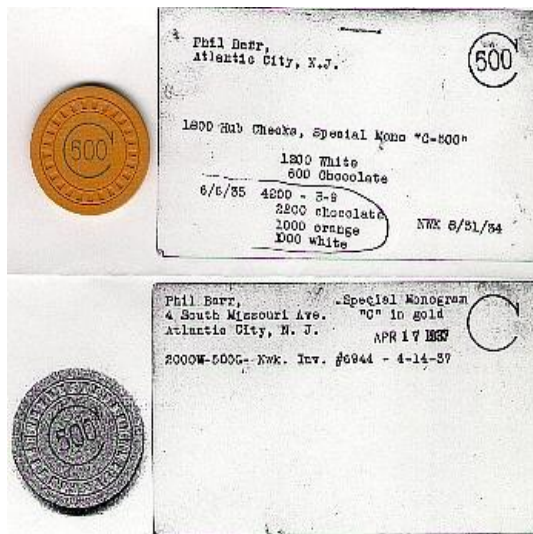


Three from New Jersey. Atlantic City, Long Branch, and Newark.
